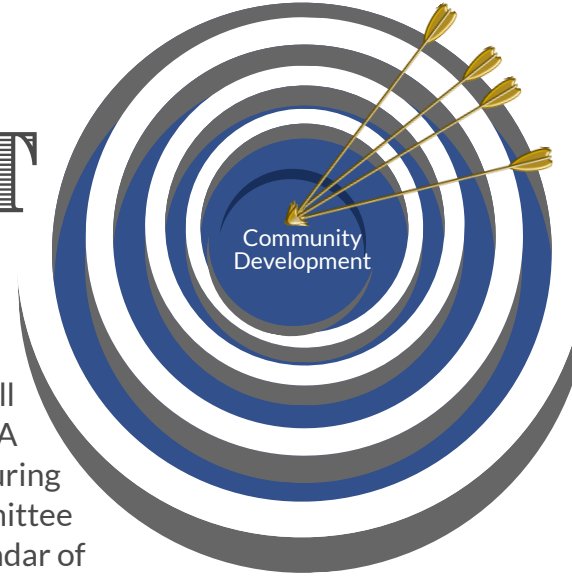


2022-2024 ON TARGET
